God works in wonderful ways. Despite our different backgrounds, He has brought us together as short-term missionaries to serve the younger generation in Japan. Our team of four members, Woun Kim, Sun Kim, Jeremy Cho, and Lawrence Lee, has chosen to respond to God's call.

Roberta Stephens, LeeAnn Hwang, and Gordon Hwang, who are currently serving as missionaries in Japan, have identified a need for contemporary style worship. Japanese Baptist Church (JBC) has graciously offered to host us for this mission project. From June 16th through the 30th, we will be leading the chapels at Soshin Girl's High School and Kanto Gakuin University. In addition to this ministry, we will be working directly with the Japanese people by teaching English and facilitating workshops.

Serving in Japan presents many challenges, both financial and cultural. The total estimated cost of travel and food expenses during the mission is \$8,000, which is beyond the amount we can afford ourselves. We humbly invite you to partner with us in this work for the Christian churches in Japan. In addition to financial support, we sincerely ask for your prayers; although these schools are historically Christian schools, most of the students attending them are non-Christians. Please pray that our ministry there would make Christianity relevant and their lives more meaningful.

The need for the Word of God in Japan is ever abundant. We sincerely ask that you consider this proposal and to respond either through prayer or financial partnership with us. We thank you and look forward to hearing from you.
